VASER ASSISTED BREAST REDUCTION

VASER Assisted Breast Reduction is the latest advancement in cosmetic breast surgeries—an innovative procedure designed to help women achieve smaller, firmer breasts without the risk of permanent scars associated with traditional breast reduction surgeries.

There is minimal postoperative pain or downtime, in addition to a rapid recovery. Fat components that tend to weigh larger breasts down are removed, allowing the breast tissue to shrink, lift, and reduce in volume. This procedure uses state-of-the-art ultrasound technology designed to gently reshape your breasts. It allows for the ability to differentiate targeted fat from other important tissues, such as nerves, blood vessels and connective tissue. Smooth results and quick healing is guaranteed with this procedure.



Frequently Asked Questions:

How does VASER Assisted Breast Reduction work?

This procedure uses an ultrasound technique to target the area around the muscles of the breasts. The patient is first given the tumescent (local) anesthesia with IV sedation; a tiny incision is made so that a probe transmitting sound energy can be inserted to liquefy the fat cells. This probe emits sound energy which works to dissolve and liquefy the fat on contact, but without damaging the surrounding tissues or muscle. Once the fat has been dissolved, it is removed through a gentle suction process designed to minimize trauma to the surrounding tissue structures such as nerves, blood vessels and other connective tissues.

Who is an ideal candidate for this procedure?

While VASER Assisted Breast Reduction can be performed on any woman seeking breast reduction surgery, it's best suited for younger patients with greater skin elasticity.

How soon will I see my results?

This depends on each patient's procedure. Typically, patients are able to see results immediately after the procedure, with final results appearing within 3 to 6 months. It is important that you establish realistic expectations through discussion with your doctor.

What is the recovery time?

Patients typically are able to return to work and normal activities within 1-3 days following the procedure.

How can I be certain VASER Assisted Breast Reduction is right for me?
